## About BPS

Badan Pusat Statistik (BPS-Statistics Indonesia) is a Non-Departmental Government Institution, directly responsible to the President. As stated in Law number 16, 1997 on Statistics, BPS is a vertical institution, with its branches spread out in all provinces and regencies/municipalities/districts. In each sub-district, there is a statistical officer (Koordinator Statistik Kecamatan - KSK) who responsible for collecting and gathering statistical data from that area.

Based on the law, BPS has a duty in collecting and disseminating basic statistics, carrying statistical coordination and cooperation, and developing statistics methodology.

BPS is headed by a Director General assisted by a Principal Secretary and four Deputy Director Generals. Currently, the Director General position is held by Dr. Choiril Maksum, assisted by Subagio Dwijosumono SE, MA as the Principal Secretary, Drs. Mulyono Muah, MA as Deputy Director General for Methodology and Statistical Information, Rusman Heriawan SE, M.Si as Deputy Director General for Social Statistics, ..... as Deputy Director General for Economic Statistics, ..... as Deputy Director General for National Accounts and Statistical Analysis.

## BPS Data

BPS as a statistical information provider for government, private institutions and community, has been trying to fulfil those information needs. Various statistical data are available at BPS, such as data on agriculture, communication, consumption expenditure, construction, energy, foreign trade, mining, finance, social, demography, manufacturing industri, national accounts, tourism, transportation, income, consumer price indices and other price indices.



## Services

BPS produces various statistical data on social and economic, which has been used widely by government, private institution and community. The data are presented in hard copy, soft copy, and internet.

In order to fulfil a various range of statistical data requirements, BPS could provide the information in any format (which is not available in the standard publication), as requested by data users (as long as the requested information is available in the micro level data set).

Besides that, BPS provides other services, such as undertaking:

1. Survey planning, sampling methodology or questionnaire design
2. Training on computer and statistics
3. Consultation on statistics
