Belarus 1944 –

During the period May 1-10th and July 1-10th each year, contact Belarus stations.

The award commemorates the liberation of Byelorussia (now known as Republic of Belarus) in World War II.

Contacts with EV prefixes = 10 points,

EU and EW prefixes = 3 points.

Contacts with veterans of liberation of Byelorussia from CIS countries (ex Russia, Ukraine and others) = 10 points.

For other continent multiplier = 3.

Repeat contacts are allowed on different bands. You need to earn the number of points as represented by subtracting 1944 from the current year. For example, in 1999, you will need 55 points.

CP Belarus –

Castles and Palaces of Belarus. Contact Byelorussian cities where old castles and palaces are located. Belarus stations need 20, Europeans 10, all others 5. Endorsement for each additional 5.

Endorsement for each added 5 such calls.

Contact Byelorussian cities which have old emblems (coats of arms).
Belarus stations need 20,
Europeans need 10,
all others 5.
Endorsements each added 5 such contacts.

Frantsysk Skaryna –

Award may be earned by contacting countries where the ancient Belarussian printing pioneer lived and worked. These are EW, LY, SP, DL, I, OZ, OK, RA, RA2.

Mirror Calls –

Contact 5 stations with "mirror" calls such as DL4LD, US4SU, UX4XU, DL2LD, etc. Endorsement for each additional 5 stations.

Old Belarus –

Contact with ancient Byelorussian stations. Belarus stations need 20 cities, EU-CIS need 10, EU need 5 and all others 2. City list as follows:

Old Minsk –

Contact City of Minsk (EU1, EW1, EV1, UC#A, RC#A, UK2A prefixes). Belarus stations need 20, EU-CIS need 10, EU need 5, all others 2.

PX-Belarus –

Contact prefixes of different stations in Belarus. (EU1, EU2, EU3, EW1, EW2, EV1, EV2, UC1, UC2, UC3, UC6, UC50..., RC2, EZ2, UK2). Belarus stations need 15, EU need 10, all others 5. Endorsement for each added 5 prefixes.

Twin Calls –

Make at least 5 contacts with "twin calls", stations whose last two letter of their call is the same as yours. For example, RA3AAO: UA1AAO, EU1FAO, DL8AO

WAARB –

work all administrative regions of Belarus (nearly 150 exist). Belarus stations need 30, Europeans need 14, all others 7. Endorsements for each 10 regions.

Worked AGB Members (W-AGB-M)

Contact any 5 AGB club members.

YL Belarus –

Contact Byelorussian YL operators. 7 points are required. Each QSO with a YL = 2 points, any club station where the YL makes a contact = 1 point, each SWL-QSL from a YL = 1 point. On March 8th of every year, you can make only 2 YL contacts. Contacts with same station on different bands are OK.

25+

Earn by working 25 contests in a year. You must have participated in the AGB-Contest.

175 + 7 –

Confirm 175 DXCC countries and 7 regions of Belarus.
